Singapore: Demurrage and Detention Tariff 2017 update

Dear Customer,

In an effort to offer our customers an overall transparent, consistent and easy shipping experience, Maersk Line has redefined our global compensation basics of Demurrage, Detention and Storage effective 1 January 2017, there are some further changes of setup with effect from **1 April 2017** as follows:

- 1) Import Detention will be calculated based on "Calendar day" going forward
- 2) Import Detention freeday will be 4 days going forward

We will be introducing the following changes to our Singapore surcharge structure and calculation methods in order to align with the new global practices. We have taken steps to minimize any customer felt impact and wish to emphasize that the new structure does not represent any significant change to the way you currently do business with Maersk Line in Singapore.

Definition:

Demurrage means compensation incurred by customer for utilising equipment beyond the given free time <u>inside</u> the terminal.

Detention means compensation incurred by customer for utilising equipment beyond the given free time outside the terminal.

Separation of Storage

We will separate Storage from Demurrage. This allows a clear distinction of the compensation applied for utilising the port, terminal or depot facilities (*Storage*), and the compensation incurred for utilisation of equipment beyond the agreed free time days inside terminals or depots (*Demurrage*).

Storage means compensation for utilising the port, terminal or depot or inland container yard facilities. For Singapore export and import shipments, the compensation for Storage related to use of Terminal or Depot facilities will continue to be settled directly by customers to terminal.

Export tariff charges

Our setup in **Singapore** is **Combined Demurrage & Detention**.

This means you will have one combined free time period and compensation for utilization of equipment inside and outside of terminals or depots, referred to as Combined Demurrage & Detention.

The Export free time is calculated from the same date of empty release of containers from the depot till the "Actual Load" date of the container, there will be a change of end trigger from vessel ETA today to Load where Maersk Line considered to increase additional 1 day export free day from 2016 tariff. Calculation method maintains as Progressive calculation.

Import tariff charges

Customers will be offered **Demurrage and Detention**.

This means you will have separate free time and compensation for utilization of equipment inside (Demurrage) and outside (Detention) of terminals or depots, start - end event of Demurrage from the same date of "Full Container Discharged to Container Gate Out" and start - end event of Detention the same date of "Container Gate Out to Empty Container Returned". Calculation method maintains as Progressive calculation.
